Go down Axel Heides Gade - approximately  
200 meters - and turn left at the end.  
LO building will be on your right side.

**By Train:**

S-train - Stop: «Dybbelsbro». Go left towards  
the shopping center «Fisketorvet» and just  
before it, take the stairs down  
and turn right. Cross the bridge, turn left and  
then right. Cross the white bridge.  
LO building will be on your right.  
It is a 10 minutes walk.
